

# Japanese Scholarships

**ST. GEORGE'S, GRENADA, SEPT. 15, 2020** – The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) in collaboration with the Government of Grenada is offering a long-term training scholarship opportunity in Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) Global Leader from 2021- 2023.

The scholarship is open to Government officials and prospective Grenadians who are expected to contribute to policy formulation and/or implementation for tackling sustainable developmental issues mainly in the fields of public policy / administration and economics.

– To be eligible to apply for this opportunity applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be 40-years-years old and under
- Must have a bachelor's or master's degree
- Must be a Grenadian national
- Must be accepted by a University in Japan (see the attached list of Universities under the program)
- Must be approved by JICA

– Scholarship benefits:

- Round trip air travel
- Living allowance for participants
- Tuition and necessary expenses for degree program offered by Japanese Universities

– Three (3) copies of all documents below must be sent to the Scholarship Desk:

- Completed application forms to be obtained from Scholarship Desk

- Certified copies of ALL academic certificates obtained from previous educational Institutions
- One (1) original TAMCC transcript and two (2) certified copies
- Certified copies of Birth Certificate
- Copies of front page with bio-data information of valid passport
- Copies of medical certificate issued by a medical doctor attesting to the physical fitness of the candidate and certifying that he/she is vaccinated and isn't suffering from any contagious or acute disease.
