PROTOCOLS FOR DONATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT AND PEOPLE OF ST. VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES (SVG) THROUGH ITS EMBASSIES AND CONSULATES

(1) Before Arrival

- **Acceptance of Donation(s)**

- (i) The Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) should be contacted through their overseas Embassies/Consulates informing of any offer made by donor agencies. A full list of the items should be provided, as well as cost/value for budgetary purposes.

- (ii) Once acceptance is ascertained, the Mission will advise on the address for shipment of the items.



- **Cost Relating to Shipment**

The MOFA will ascertain whether the donor, the Missions/Consulates, line Ministries or MOFA will cover the cost of the items. Further, it is important to receive this information on a timely basis to allow sufficient time to access funds. Persons desirous of sending items to private individuals would be required to make their own arrangements, as priority is being given to the Government's relief efforts.

- **Transmission of Information to the Ministry**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs should be informed of all donations via their overseas Embassies and Consulates, especially in cases where items donated are shipped directly to the line Ministries or designated charitable organisations identified below under heading duty-free concessions.

Additionally, in such cases the documentation for shipment should be sent through the High Commission/ Embassies which should comprise:

- (i) A list of the items donated.
- (ii) Valuation list or cost of items (*please see attached valuation template document*).
- (iii) All packages must be clearly and appropriately labelled.

- **Arrival of Items to SVG**

Upon arrival of the items to SVG the below-mentioned steps will be adhered to:

- (i) The Ministry will facilitate the process for clearance where necessary;
- (ii) The Ministry will then liaise with the respective line Ministries or designated charitable Organisations for the handing over of items.
- (iii) The Missions/Consulates will then be informed by MOFA when this process has been completed.

DUTY-FREE CONCESSIONS-RELIEF SUPPLIES

Please be advised that, until further notice, the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines has granted approval for a **100 per-cent waiver of IMPORT DUTY, VAT, EXCISE DUTIES, CUSTOMS SERVICE CHARGE AND THE BOTTLE LEVY ON ALL RELIEF SUPPLIES** imported into the State from friendly Governments, international organisations, charitable bodies, other entities and individuals, and **consigned** to the following:



- a) The National Emergency Management Organisation
- b) The SVG Red Cross
- c) Rotary Clubs
- d) Lions Clubs
- e) Chamber of Industry and Commerce
- f) Or any other established religious, charitable and civic organisations.

Additionally, in view of the acute shortage of potable water in the country, Cabinet also granted approval for a **100 per-cent waiver of all import taxes (IMPORT DUTY, VAT, EXCISE DUTIES, CUSTOMS SERVICE CHARGE AND THE BOTTLE LEVY) on all water imported into the State.**

Cabinet has also granted approval for a **100 per-cent waiver of VAT**, Import and other related Duties on all barrels with effect **from April 12, 2021 to June 30, 2021.**
