

INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR CITIZENSHIP CHILDREN OF GRENADIAN PARENT(S) UNDER/OVER 18 YEARS

- 1. One completed form **signed** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
- **2.** Four Passport size photographs (50mm x 50mm) of the applicant **CERTIFIED** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public: "I certify that this is a true likeness of"
- 3. ORIGINAL and ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY of Birth Certificate of applicant.

The original Birth Certificate **MUST** be apostilled. Please click on the link below for information on obtaining an apostilled document.

Marriage Certificate supporting your application **MUST** also be apostille (Only if married outside of Grenada).

- **4.** Letter from the GP confirming that you are registered and are in good health.
- 5. ORIGINAL and ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY of Birth Certificate of Grenadian Parent.
- **6.** Copy of British passport.
- **7.** Fees: **Citizenship** \$250.00 plus **Application fee** \$100.00. Cheque to be made payable to "Government of Grenada".
