

INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR CITIZENSHIP MARRIED TO A GRENADIAN BY NATURALIZATION

- 1. Forms to be completed and signed by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
- 2. Four passport size photographs **CERTIFIED** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public. "I certify that this is a true likeness of......"
- **3. ORIGINAL** and **ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY** of Birth Certificate. If name does not appear on Birth Certificate, an **ORIGINAL** Affidavit is required.

The original Birth Certificate **MUST** be apostilled. Please click on the link below for information on obtaining an apostilled document.

Marriage Certificate supporting your application **MUST** also be apostilled (Only if married outside of Grenada).

- 4. Letter from the GP confirming that you are registered and are in good health.
- 5. ORIGINAL and ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY of Spouse's Birth Certificate.
- 6. ORIGINAL and ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY of Marriage Certificate.
- 7. Letter of Concurrence from Grenadian Spouse.
- 8. A copy of data page of all passports, both applicant and spouse.
- 9. On a plain paper:

Fee **EC\$2500.00** plus **EC\$100.00** application fee (converted to Pounds) by cheque made payable to "Government of Grenada".
