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<u>APPLICATION REOUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL, FIRST TIME AND LOST, STOLEN</u> <u>DAMAGE OF</u>

CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY GRENADA PASSPORT

1. Please read and follow the instructions at the top of the passport application form. IF MAILING YOUR APPLICATION, PLEASE USE AN EXPRESS SERVICE THAT CAN BE TRACKED.

2. Applicants <u>MUST</u> sign the form in the space provided above Section 1 and in Section 10.

3. Applications <u>MUST</u> be handwritten, using **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink and in **BLOCK CAPITAL** letters.

4. Applicant <u>MUST</u> complete Sections 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, & 10 and, if applicable, Sections 2, 6, 8, and 9.

5. Applicants who are married, divorced or separated <u>MUST</u> also complete Section 2.

6 Section 11: – Recommender must be a citizen of Grenada non-family member if you do not know of any Grenadian citizen; in that case, the recommender <u>MUST</u> be someone in the legal profession, and they MUST also endorse the reverse side of ONE of the applicant's photos as indicated in the instructions on the first page of the application. See Section on Photographs of Passport Application for details ("I certify that this is a true likeness of the passport holder Mr./Mrs./Ms."). The recommender cannot be the applicant's relative (direct or in-law).

7. Two passport-size pictures no older than six (6) months MUST be submitted with the application. The **Recommender in Section 11** <u>MUST</u> endorse the reverse side of one of the pictures. See Item 6 above and **PART A** of the application form for details.

8. Applicants for Lost or Stolen Passport -. Applicants <u>MUST</u> complete the passport application form, the Lost, stolen and damaged form, and the Statutory Declaration. The Statutory Declaration <u>MUST</u> be completed in the presence of someone in the legal profession

9. If applying for a passport for the first time, the applicant <u>must</u> complete the passport application form and First-Time Applicants Questionnaire. Documents required:

- Full Birth Certificate
- Parents Birth Grenadian Certificate
- Copy of Passport

10. Specifications for photographs:

- i. No glasses
- ii. No hair bands visible
- iii. No big earrings
- iv. Ears must be visible
- v. Hair must be away from the face and not cover the forehead
- vi. Chest and shoulders must be covered

11. Children under 16 years of age MUST have written consent from their parents or legal guardians when applying for a passport.

- 12. Applicants who are married MUST submit their original marriage certificate. If they are divorced, please submit their original divorce decree.
- 13. Applicants MUST:
- i. Submit **ORIGINAL** Birth Certificate and
- ii. Certificate of Naturalization or Registration (if applicable), and
- iii. Surrender current (whether expired or not) passport (Grenada) with application
