



INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR CITIZENSHIP
MARRIED TO A GRENADIAN BY NATURALIZATION

1. Forms to be completed and signed by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
2. Four passport size photographs **CERTIFIED** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public. "I certify that this is a true likeness of....."
3. **ORIGINAL** and **ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY** of Birth Certificate. If name does not appear on Birth Certificate, an **ORIGINAL** Affidavit is required.

The original Birth Certificate **MUST** be apostilled. Please click on the link below for information on obtaining an apostilled document.

Marriage Certificate supporting your application **MUST** also be apostilled (Only if married outside of Grenada).

4. Letter from the GP confirming that you are registered and are in good health.
5. **ORIGINAL** and **ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY** of Spouse's Birth Certificate.
6. **ORIGINAL** and **ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY** of Marriage Certificate.
7. Letter of Concurrence from Grenadian Spouse.
8. A copy of the data page of all passports, both applicant and spouse.
9. On plain paper:
 - Name of Applicant
 - Date of birth
 - Occupation
 - Telephone number
 - Parent's name and nationality
